The EIANZ has relied on these supporters to ensure this training remains accessible, during a financially constrained period.

Learning to Adapt has become a valuable part of professional capacity building for climate change adaptation that will be offered for the first time outside NSW over the coming year. Our intent is that Learning to Adapt continues to enhance the skills of those adapting Australia for future living with climate change over the years to come.

LEARNING TO ADAPT - THE PROGRAM

Learning to Adapt is a training program designed to upskill environment and sustainability professionals on climate change adaptation and is run over 3 separate full days of intensive collaborative learning. Learning to Adapt is designed by experienced sustainability educators to engage participants in case studies presented by recognised expert guest speakers in climate change adaptation. Participants apply their learning by working together to deliver group projects.

Modules covered over the 3 days are:

Applying the science of climate change impacts

Assessing and managing climate change risks

Applying and communicating climate change adaptation policy and standards

As a result of the highly successful short course pilot held in NSW between April and June of 2014 and delivered in partnership with the NSW Office of Environment and Heritage with the support of the University of NSW, the Green Building Council of Australia and the Infrastructure Sustainability Council of Australia, Learning to Adapt will be offered in Victoria, Queensland and again in NSW during 2014/15.
