

# The UNSW Masters of Environmental Management

A 2015 survey of over 100 MEM graduates from the last 15 years and some of their employers confirms that the reputation of the MEM and UNSW is very highly regarded both by graduates and their employers.

The most common reason for graduates to undertake the MEM is to embark on a different career. 90% of MEM graduates now work in environmental management roles, most in Australia, particularly NSW, but a sizeable portion (28%) have found use for their MEM skills overseas, particularly in the Asia-Pacific region.

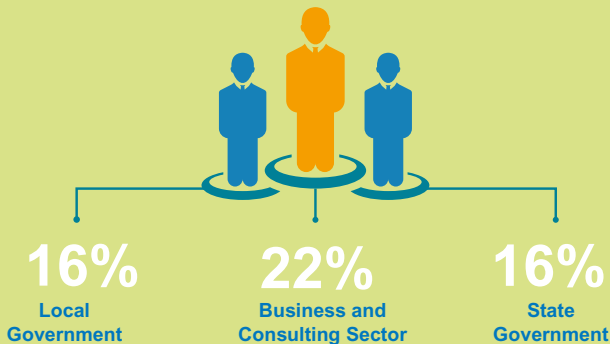

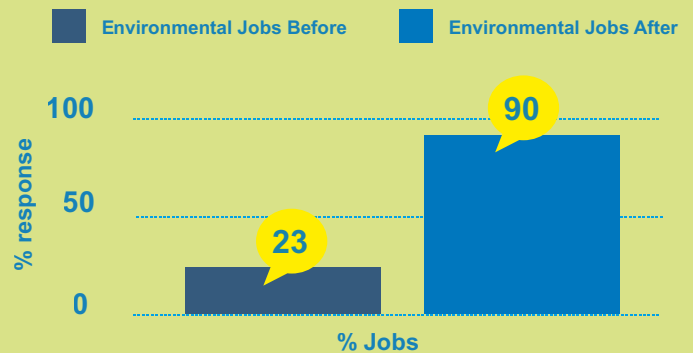
