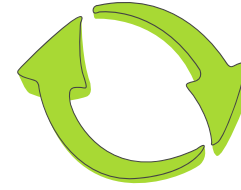
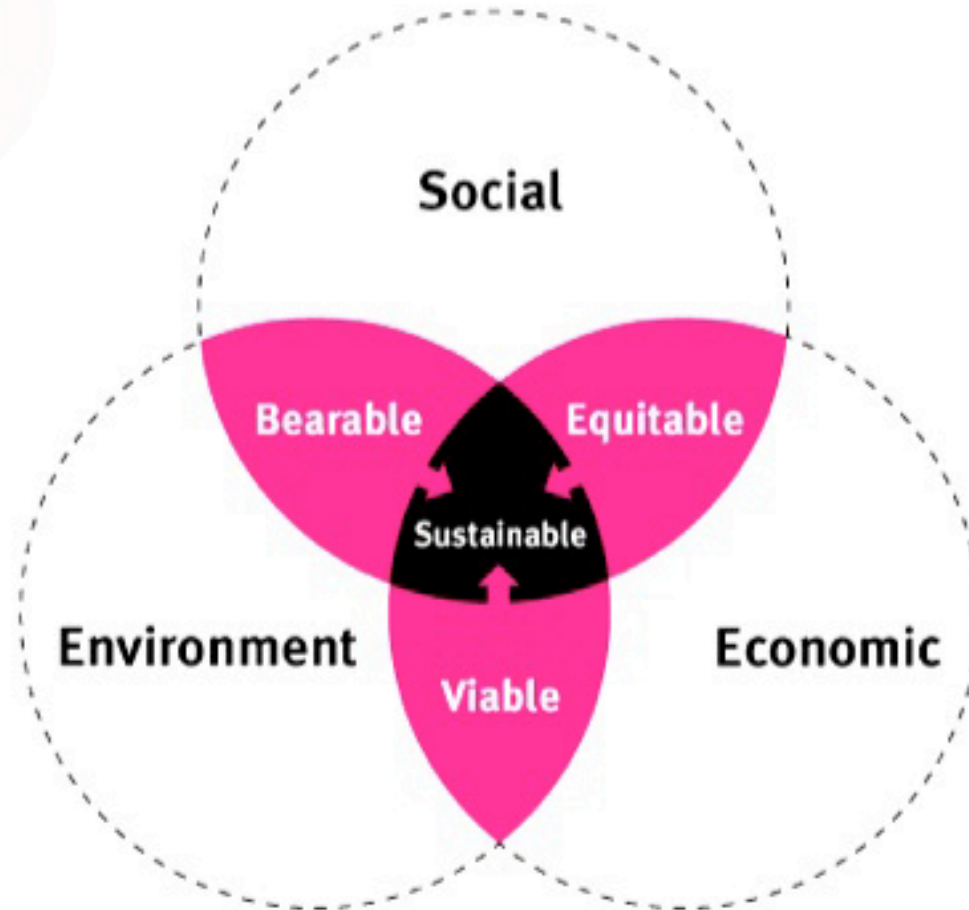

The thinking behind the survey

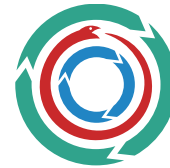
- We asked you about skills that almost everybody could use at work, in class and at home
