The Gen Green 4 Australia Teacher Survey and the Gen Green 4 Australia Apprentice and Trainee Survey are open from 14 October 2013 to 20 December 2013. During this time the survey will be available online via **www.gengreen.org.au** or you can link via Facebook – Gen Green 4 Australia.

The surveys are made up of scaled responses and allow for additional free text answers. The surveys have been designed with help from experienced VET researchers at Deakin and La Trobe Universities and the questions are based on a series of three smaller surveys conducted between 2008 and 2012.
