

Celebrating 1O successful years of learning to adapt L2A is excited to be responding to local, national and global challenges by moving online in 2O21. Informed by a 2O2O EIANZ members survey, L2A 2O21 will deliver targeted skills development on climate change adaptation and resilience planning, climate change risk assessment and climate change projections and science. The approach will be a curated approach, structured around expert guest speakers and online resources with each course delivered over 3 x half days.

The focus of the courses will be on practical climate change related skills and knowledge that can be applied by experienced environmental practitioners. The scope will be NSW State based.





Online short courses

Across each course international, national, state and local climate change policy and legislation will be addressed as cross-cutting themes, to ensure sessions focus on practical skills.

As well as a focus on the formation of practical skills relevant to environmental practitioners, each course delivery will provide online networking opportunities and build the L2A community of practice. Each online course will be 3 x half day sessions delivered 1 week apart consisting of:
